

Note for users of Adaptive Integration's data agent

In order to support flexible calendar/time requirements from a data import/export perspective, changes have been made to the Adaptive data agent and Pentaho Kettle plugins. If you are an early adopter customer for 2017.2, please verify that you meet any of the following conditions -

1. A new customer who has never installed a data agent before and would like to configure a new agent to import/export data out of an on-premises data source. In this case, please use the 2017.2 download link below to download the data agent.
2. If your Planning instance calendar has changed (e.g. monthly granularity has changed to weekly) and you have Pentaho-based scripted loaders that invoke import/export steps from Planning, then you will need to modify your Pentaho Kettle scripts. In addition to making changes to your scripts, you will have to download the 2017.2 Kettle plugins to make use of the newer flexible time APIs from Planning. If you are running a newer Kettle script (Kettle 6 or higher), then use the 2017.2 download link to download the data agent. If you have an older Kettle script (Kettle 4.4), then use the 2017.2 legacy agent link to download the data agent.
